



Ascend's Code of Conduct

The Ascend staff strives to provide you/your child with a fun, memorable, and safe camping experience. Each camper has a responsibility to act in a way that assures a positive experience for all.

Ascend believes in equality for all mankind. Hate is not welcome at our facility. All campers are required to follow the guidelines below.

- Campers shall be respectful of others
- Campers shall follow directions from camp staff
- Stealing from the property is prohibited
- Damaging the property is prohibited
- Inappropriate physical contact will not be tolerated
- Profanity and cursing is prohibited
- Possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, or any illegal substances is prohibited
- Possession of weapons, or anything that can be used as a weapon is prohibited

Steps Taken for Failure to Follow these Guidelines

- Counselor will redirect the camper to a more appropriate behavior.
- The camper will be reminded of the behavior guidelines.
- If the behavior persists, staff will discuss the problem with a parent/guardian.
- The staff will document the situation. The written documents will include what the behavior problem is, what provoked the problem, and the corrective action taken.
- If the problem persists to the point where a second phone call becomes necessary, the Camp Director may find it necessary to have the camper picked up early from camp.
- If a camper's behavior at any time threatens the immediate safety of him/her, other campers, or staff, the parent/guardian will be notified and expected to pick-up the child immediately.

Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct may result in the removal from the program and/or additional fees. There will be no refunds given for campers who are removed from the program due to violations of the Code of Conduct.

Dress Code

Out of safety and consideration to our campers, we ask that our campers follow the dress code below:

- Shorts, skorts, skirts, and dresses must be to the knee for females over the age of 12
- Shorts, swimming shorts, etc must be to the knee for males over the age of 12
- Two-piece swimsuits (bikinis) are not permitted
- When out of the swimming area, we kindly ask our campers to wrap a towel around them.
